Semester dates

- Classes started on Thursday 9th September and will finish on Friday 22nd December.
- The Christmas break is from 23rd December to the 6th January.
- Your exams for the first semester will be in January, from the 7th onwards. Check the timetable carefully (Convocatoria Ordinaria).
- Other public holidays:
 - 12th October (Día de la Hispanidad)
 - 1st November (Todos los santos)
 - 6th and 8th December (Día de la Constitución / La Inmaculada Concepción)

Assessment at the FTI

- Continuous assessment:
 - 50% coursework
 - 10% attendance and participation
 - 40% final exam
- Convocatoria Ordinaria
 - 100% exam (only if you did not attend 50% (minimum) classes or did not hand in the coursework)
- Convocatoria Extraordinaria/Especial
 - These are re-sit examining sessions in July and November

How to change your Learning Agreement

LA (pdf format)

- Make out a new LA, agreed with and signed by your home coordinator
- Check the subject codes carefully
- Send it me to be signed
- Send it to the Humanities Mobility Office so that you are registered in the new subjects

OLA

- Modify your agreement on the platform and sign it
- Ask your home coordinator to sign it
- Ask me to sign it after the other two signatures have been uploaded
- Download it and send it the Humanities Mobility Office so that you are registered in the new subjects

• Deadline: 9th October

Spanish as a Foreign Language vs Lengua A español

- Lengua A is a Spanish language subject for L1 speakers of Spanish. You should only choose it if you have an advanced level.
- Español lengua extranjera 6 ECTS
 - Can be added to your LA
 - Classes are not in the FTI, but on the Tafira Campus in the Aula de Idiomas (Bus 25 – 10-15 minute journey)
 - If you did not include this in your LA to start with, write to Matías mvedaschi@fulp.es

Our Covid policy

- Our classrooms are cleaned and disinfected at the start of the day and in between every group change.
- The teacher's desk is disinfected every time a class changes.

- You must wear a mask at all times when you are inside the building.
- Use hand sanitiser on entering the building.
- We recommend that you go back to the same seat if you have a follow-on class in the same room.

Our Covid policy

Each classroom has a Covid capacity. This is indicated on a sign outside the room.

- If the alert level goes down to 2 or 1, the classrooms will be used at their regular capacity.
- Today we are in level 2!! The social distancing rule is 50cm, so we do not need to use the overspill classrooms. You can sit next to each other and work in groups ©
